- What has inspired you to pursue a career in welding and welding technology
- What you hope to achieve by completing the post-secondary program
- What are your future endeavors in the industry
- What do you hope to contribute to the industry in the future and how do you plan to meet your career goals

### **2. Resume**

The resume is a detailed list of all activities the candidate has taken an interest in and has been involved with. Candidates should include the most complete listing possible that could include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Awards
- Clubs/Memberships
- Co-op Jobs
- Part-Time/Full-Time Employment (previous and/or current)
- Projects
- Scholastic Achievement (educational history)
- School Associations
- Sports
- Student Government
- Volunteer work

### **3. Academic Transcript**

Candidates are required to provide a printout or electronic copy of their most recent undergraduate transcript.

All applications will be submitted to ESAB Group Canada, Inc. by mail, fax or email.

The scholarship recipient will be announced in August and formally recognized at the CWA Annual Awards in September 2010.
